Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Lost Property:

A reminder for families to label school clothing, as every week, we are collecting a large amount of unlabelled clothing which then becomes our 2nd hand uniform pool. If your child has lost a piece of clothing, please check the lost property. Thank you to families for ensuring your children are in full **school uniform. If you need to update your child's uniform or are looking for some additional pieces**, visit the P&C run 2nd Hand Uniform store. They have a large variety of sizes at very cheap prices.

Update Family Details:

It is very important that you let the office know of any changes to your family details especially contact numbers. We have already had instances where parents have not been able to be contacted because they have incorrect numbers listed and this can cause much distress to the sick child.

If your child has a Health Care Action Plan or an Asthma Action Plan that needs to be updated, please see your doctor for a new one. If your child has a Health Care Plan please make sure that the office has one on file.

Road Safety:

The beginning and end of the school day are busy times for pedestrians and drivers outside schools. Over the last months we have observed a number of activities that could potentially place children at risk of serious injury.

You can help keep children safe by remembering the following:

- always cross the road at the crossing and wait for the crossing supervisor
- never call out to children from across the road - it is very dangerous
- always take extra care when driving in 40km school zones
- follow all parking signs - these help keep children as safe as possible
- park responsibly even if this means you have to walk further to the school gate
- never double park - it is illegal and puts children at risk
- never do a U-turn or three-point turn outside the school as it puts children at risk of harm
- model safe and considerate pedestrian and driver behaviours to your children.
