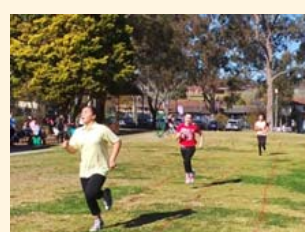
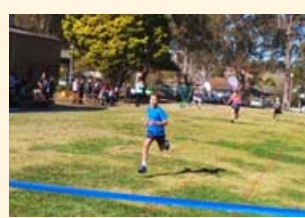
Annual K-6 Athletics Carnival

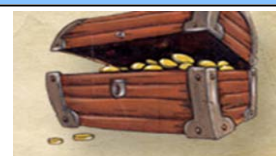
